September 28, 2023 - NTIA Notifies FCC that CBRS Users in Hawaii May Temporarily Use Schedulers Instead of ESC, "By this letter, the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) provides notice to the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) of a temporary arrangement with the Department of the Navy (Navy) that will allow Citizens Broadband Radio Service (CBRS) users-including Priority Access Licensees-to begin operating in Hawaii in the 3550-3650 MHz band before Environmental Sensing Capability (ESC) sensors are locally deployed. Under this arrangement, the Navy will retain continuous access to three 10-megahertz channels in the 3550-3650 MHz band in and around Hawaii, 2 leaving seven-10 megahertz channels available for CBRS use. The Navy will retain priority rights to the remainder of the 3550-3650 MHz band on an "as needed" basis consistent with Part 96 of the Commission's rules, and the Navy's spectrum use will be coordinated via the TARDyS3 scheduling portal. September 28, 2023 - FCC Commissioner Breden Carr Opposes Plan for Government Control of the Internet from an executive order from President Biden. Click here for full statement. Of interest to broadband Carr claims "This utility-style regulation will slow down rural broadband builds. The last thing that broadband builders across rural America need right now is a regulatory onslaught from Washington. Yet that is precisely what Title II utility-style regulation entails. As the FCC determined in 2017, the agency's 2015 experiment with Title II regulation negatively impacted small ISPs that serve rural communities. Indeed, those small ISPs reduced broadband infrastructure investment due to the FCC's 2015 Title II decision. Compare that to the significant narrowing of the digital divide that we have seen in the years since the 2017 decision-a decision that returned the Internet to the same, bipartisan, and light-touch regulatory framework under which the Internet flourished for more than 20 years."
